This year as before we will be holding our popular debate, when speakers for the Republican candidate and the Democratic candidate will argue the case for their candidate, and then answer questions from the floor, about what is a fascinating and highly contentious US election.

Dr Jan Halper will speak for the Republicans. She has taken a sabbatical from her role as Managing Director of Presage Advisory to assume leadership of Republicans Overseas UK to focus on the 2016 Presidential elections. She is an internationally recognised expert in strategy and change, and author of the International bestseller, "Quiet Desperation: The Truth About Successful Men". She has a doctorate from Columbia Pacific University in Organisational Psychology. She has appeared on a number of television programmes.

Bill Barnard will speak for the Democrats. He has had a thirty year career in University teaching, research and administration at various universities in Alabama. He has been active in politics in his home state for over 25 years. He was for two terms Chair, Democrats Abroad UK, and is at present a member of the Executive Committee of Democrats UK. He is a frequent commentator on American politics on various BBC formats, and a frequent contributor on Sky News.
