We are privileged in having Peter Sands to speak to us on a highly topical subject.

Peter Sands is the Group Chief Executive of Standard Chartered plc.

After graduating from Brasenose College at Oxford in 1984, he joined the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, which he left to take a Harkness Fellowship at Harvard University to earn a master's degree in public administration. He held various posts at McKinsey & Co, becoming a director in 2000. He joined Standard Chartered as Group Finance Director in 2002.

Peter Sands became Chief Executive in 2006, steering Standard Chartered through the financial crisis with no recourse to taxpayers' money. Running a company which operates in over 70 countries, Peter travels extensively and will share perspectives from Asia, Africa and the Middle East.

Peter Sands is Lead Non-Executive at the Department of Health and is the co-chair of the India UK CEO Forum. Peter holds a number of board memberships, is a member of the Global CEO Council set up by the Chinese People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries to advise the Chinese government and also serves on the Monetary Authority of Singapore's International Advisory Panel.

Peter is married to writer Betsy Tobin (but of course opposes the Tobin tax!) and is a keen Arsenal fan.

The Annual lecture will be preceded by an AGM at 5:30 PM, for which papers will be sent out separately. We hope there will be an excellent turnout to hear Peter, and that most Fellows will also be able to attend the AGM.
